

Fire Safety Rules

- Adults must supervise children at all times.
- Keep fire small and keep a bucket of water and shovel nearby.
- Extinguish fires before going to sleep and when you leave your site.
- Pour water on fire, drown all embers and step back to avoid hot steam.
- Stir and turn ashes, coals and wood on all sides.
- Drown and stir again.
- At a safe distance, feel for heat with back of your hand to be sure nothing is still smoldering.
- If you feel heat, stir more water into ashes until cool.

Group, Equestrian, and Backpack Camp Regulations

East Bay Regional Park District Ordinance 38

Quiet Hours are from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Check In is at 2 p.m. **Check Out** is at noon.

Park Entry Gates are locked at 10 p.m. No entry permitted after closure. Opening hours vary by park.

Group Size may not exceed site capacity, including total number of adults and youth staying at the site.

Minors under 18 must be supervised by one, responsible adult (age 21+) per 10 minors.

Parking Passes will be mailed 7-10 days before your reservation. Parking capacity is limited at site, so no additional passes may be purchased. Please carpool.

Vehicle Access to Group Camps is permitted only with a valid overnight parking pass and gate lock combination. Keep gates locked at all times. Access limited to one group trip in and out (no shuttling). Park in permitted areas.

No Alcohol at Group Camps except designated sites or by permit. Questions? Call (888) 327-2757 option 2.

Pets must be leashed at all times, where permitted, and kept in vehicle or tent during Quiet Hours. Put dog waste in dumpsters.

Smoking is prohibited except in overnight campsites.

Fires are permitted only in designated areas (*see reverse for Fire Safety Rules*). Stoves and charcoal grills must be placed in designated cooking areas. Fires and smoking are prohibited during high fire danger conditions.

Generators, Fireworks, Weapons and Firearms are prohibited.

Amplified Sound is prohibited, except for battery-powered and not audible more than 25 feet away.

Plants and Animals are protected by law. No firewood gathering. Store-bought, pest-free firewood is preferred.

Site-Specific Rules may apply at different parks. Please refer to your camping reservations contract or Park Staff.

Public Advertising of event allowed only with 15 days pre-approval from Reservations Office.

Group Camping within the park is by reservation only. Please phone (888) 327-2757, option 2.

Stay Duration in group sites is limited to 7 days per month and 30 total nights per year. For backpack sites, stay limits vary by park.
