Swim Area Entry
No alcohol, glass containers, personal barbecues, dogs, bicycles, scooters, or fishing. No diapers, including swim diapers, are allowed in the water.

Main Park Entrance
Dogs must be on leash at all times anywhere in the park.

Alameda Creek Trail
Paved side: No horses; dogs must be on leash at all times. 1.13 mi. east from Sequoia Bridge to Mission Blvd. 1.37 mi. east from Sequoia Bridge to Niles Staging Area at Old Canyon Road.
Unpaved side: 1.89 mi. east from Sequoia Bridge to Mission Blvd. 2.14 mi. east from Sequoia Bridge to Niles Staging Area.

RECREATIONAL AND NATURAL UNITS
The Quarry Lakes Recreation Unit includes Horseshoe Lake and Rainbow Lake and the turf, beach, swimming, and picnic areas around those lakes. Visitors can picnic, play volleyball, fish, swim in the designated swim beach, and enjoy non-gasoline-powered watercraft. The Natural Unit includes Willow Slough, Lago Los Osos, and the surrounding areas, where visitors can hike, observe nature, walk dogs on leash, and ride bicycles. No water contact of any type is allowed in Willow Slough or Lago Los Osos. **Dogs must always be kept on leash throughout the entire park**, and no water contact of any kind is allowed. **Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in Quarry Lakes** except by permit within the Ensenada, Osprey, and Lampert Knoll reservable picnic areas only.
