Old Briones Trail has an array of native flowers in the Spring. It is a relatively short hike to Briones Crest which opens to spectacular panoramic views of the East Bay.

There are two trailheads for this trail. One begins at Bear Creek staging area, and the other begins at the end of Briones Road.



Trail Access Information

Warning: Trail conditions may have changed since this trail was assessed. Temporary obstructions (e.g. fallen trees or landslides) may not have been mapped. Maximum grades and cross slopes may vary.

Obstructions less than 2.0 in (5.0 cm) or outside the tread area 120 in (3 m) wide by 96 in (2.4 m) high were not measured. Minimum clearance boundaries were at least 20 in (50 cm) high.
