



Lafayette-Moraga Regional Trail Rehabilitation Project

What: Repaving of approximately 3 miles of trail.

Why: To provide a safe and enjoyable experience for trail users.

Where: Trail segments in poor condition/areas of heavy use.

A map is provided on the reverse side.

When: August 1st - November 18, 2011 (trail closures)

About the Trail Project:

The goal of this project is to accomplish the following:

- ◇ Rehabilitate Damaged Sections of Trail Pavement
- ◇ Widen existing substandard trail segments to ten feet.
- ◇ Make portions of the trail ADA compliant.

The construction schedule has been developed to avoid environmental impacts and to maintain school access routes when feasible.

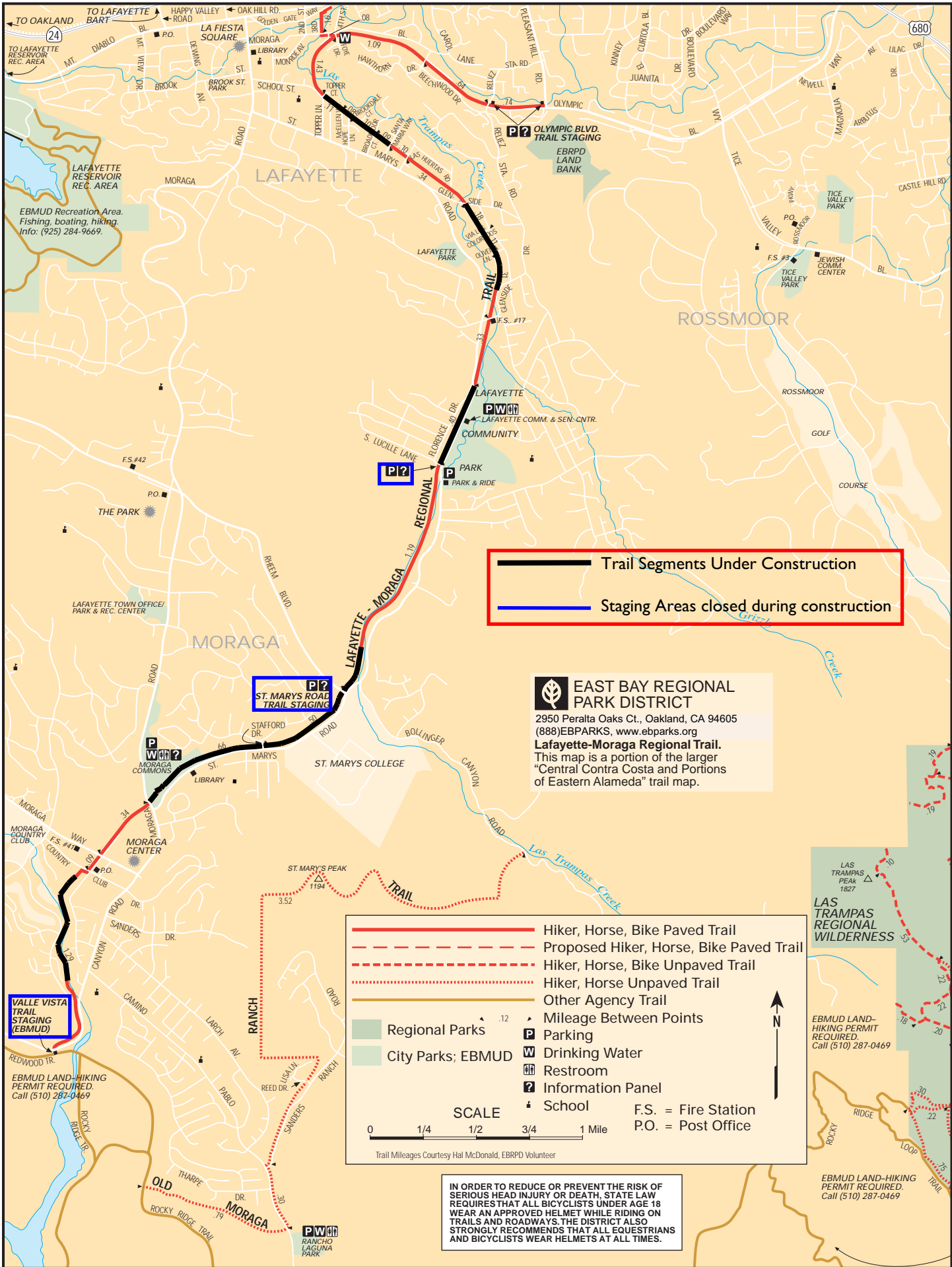
Trail Closures Note:

Trail Rehabilitation work will require trail closures. The St. Mary's Road Trail Staging area will be closed for the duration of the project. The Valle Vista Trail Staging area will be partially closed as needed for truck turnaround. Scheduled closure dates for individual trail segments are approximate and updates will be posted on signs at trail entry points and on EBRPD website.
