FIELD TRIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors has scheduled a field trip to commence at **9:30 a.m. on Friday, October 28, 2011**, at the EBRPD Administrative Office, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. The Board field trip will include stops at Pleasanton Ridge, Vargas Plateau, Sunol and Mission Peak. It is anticipated that the group will return at approximately 4:00 p.m.

*** All participants will be riding in EBRPD vehicles while touring properties. For the Owens property portion of the tour, there will be no private vehicle access or parking along Palomares Road. We will not be returning to this entry at any time during the tour.**

***Depart Peralta Oaks**

9:30 a.m.

(Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than **9:15 a.m.**)

From Peralta Oaks Court take 580 East to the Eden Canyon exit. At the stop, turn right on Paloverde Road. Proceed a short distance and turn right on Palomares Rd. Proceed approximately 4.5 miles to an unmarked gate at the apex of a sharp right turn.

Arrive at the gate to Owens Property, Pleasanton Ridge Regional Park 10:00 a.m.

*The Board will be touring the former Owens parcel now in land Bank located east of Palomares Canyon and running up to Sunol Ridge. They will also view the South Owens and Robertson properties from the ridge line to the south. The group will be driving through vast acreage with open grassland and Bay/Oak woodlands. Actual route may be modified due to road conditions. We will exit through existing park property at **Santos Ranch Road** and continue along **Foothill Road** to the town of **Sunol**.*

Arrive at the Hetch Hetchy/Sunol Service Yard

12:00 p.m.

The service yard is located at 11760 Main St., Sunol. The board will eat lunch and hear a presentation provided by staff. Enroute to Vallejo Mills, the Board will view the Zwissig property along Niles Canyon Road.

**** Lunch will not be provided for the public.**

From the Hetch Hetchy/Sunol service yard, turn right on Niles Canyon Road and proceed 5.75 miles to the City of Fremont's Vallejo Mills Historical Park.

Arrive at the City of Fremont Vallejo Mills Trailhead and Staging Area 1:45 p.m.

The Board will be visiting the site of a potential trail link to the south side of Garin/Dry Creek Regional Park. Enroute to Mission Peak Regional Preserve, they will view Vargas Plateau Regional Park and Ohlone College.

From Vallejo Mills, travel South along Mission Blvd. approximately 4.75 miles to Stanford Staging Area, Mission Peak Regional Preserve.

Arrive at Stanford Staging Area, Mission Peak Regional Preserve 2:25 p.m.

The Board will view the proposed expansion of the existing staging area at the end of Stanford.

Arrive Peralta Oaks 3:50 p.m.
