The East Bay Regional Park District has prepared a restoration plan for Redwood Regional Park Serpentine Prairie that will bring back the vitality and botanical diversity of the Serpentine Prairie, including the endangered Presidio clarkia, while continuing to provide for the enjoyment of park users. This restoration work will be multi-phased over a period of 3 to

4 years. It will include removal of trees not endemic to prairie habitat, closing severely impacted areas for recovery, removal of informal trails and creation of a new Serpentine Prairie loop trail and interpretive overlook, installation of informational signage, and may include limited future prescribed burns and sheep grazing as part of a long-term adaptive management program.

Beginning May 4, 2009 the plan describing these resource management actions and the accompanying California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Initial Study document will be available for public review for 30 days.
