

## Redwood Regional Park Eucalyptus and Pine Removal Project

The East Bay Regional Park District has hired Phillips & Jordan to remove eucalyptus and Monterey pine on a 50 acre site in Redwood Regional Park on both sides of the East Ridge Trail. The East Ridge Trail will be closed on weekdays during the project, which is scheduled to begin in July 2008. Weather may delay project completion.

Removal of eucalyptus trees and Monterey pines will help reduce the fire hazard while maintaining the more fire resistant native oak and California Bay trees as a shaded fuel break. Follow-up treatment will include erosion control measures where needed, monitoring, and site rehabilitation, and invasive species control.
