WATER EXCEEDS STATE STANDARDS

Weekly testing for bacteria has exceeded state health standards. Beach water contact may cause illness. Do not swallow water. Shower after water contact. Be advised that there is always some risk with beach water contact. Water quality conditions can change at any time.

Current Condition **Yellow Light** (Beach is open. Increased health risk.)

Water Quality “Stop Light” Designations:

Red Light: *Beach is Closed. No swimming, wading or water contact. There is a Water Quality Hazard.*

Yellow Light: *Beach is Open. There is an increased health risk for swimming and wading. Bacteria results do NOT meet the State Health Standards.*

Green Light: *Beach is Open. Low health risk for water contact. Bacteria results are within the State Health Standard Limits.*
