Additional permits are required for access to the Ohlone Wilderness Trail and East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) property.

How to Make Your Reservation

Reserve by phone or in person at Park District headquarters. Family campsites and group sites may also be reserved online.

For family campgrounds, reserve at least two days in advance, and up to 12 weeks in advance. Any sites not reserved will be made available at the campground on a first-come, first-served basis. Advance reservations are encouraged, as sites usually sell out every weekend.

For all other sites, reserve at least five business days in advance. Group and backpack sites become available for reservations in November for Alameda and Contra Costa county residents, and the following February for non-residents.

Changes, Cancellations, and Refunds

Call the Reservations Department to change or cancel your reservations. There are no refunds for dropping nights before or on major holiday weekends.

No refunds are offered due to unfavorable weather.

The \$8 change fee or cancellation fee is in addition to the non-refundable reservation fee of \$8.

Family Campgrounds

If you make changes or cancel your trip more than three days before your camping trip, an \$8 change/ cancellation fee per site applies. No changes may be made less than three days in advance.

If you call to cancel your trip fewer than three days before your trip, there is no site fee refund and an \$8 cancellation fee applies.

All other Group and Cabin Sites

Cancellations made:

- 30 days or more prior to the reservation –
- 15 days or more prior to the reservation 74% refund
- Less than 15 days, but more than 7 days -50% refund
- Under 7 days no refund



 Available in 12 parks, for groups of 11 to 300 people. Developed and primitive sites are available.
