## Trail Description

The Tassajara Creek Trail is a multi-use paved and unpaved trail located along Tassajara Creek and Tassajara Ridge. This important regional trail links east Dublin's rapidly-expanding residential areas with recreational facilities, jobs, retail services and BART. The trail was built and is owned by the City of Dublin, and maintained by EBRPD on the section that heads north from Dublin Blvd. to Somerset Lane, passing through Emerald Glen Park and Crossing Geason Drive, then continues to connect with Tassajara Creek Regional Park.

The trail then continues through Dougherty Valley Open Space and continues through the Alamo Creek Subdivision, to Camino Tassajara. The trail will eventually cross Camino Tassajara and connect to Mt. Diablo State Park and Morgan Territory via Finley Road.
