FIELD TRIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS

AGENDA

The field trip below has been scheduled for the East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors, and will commence at 10:00 a.m. on **Tuesday, June 30, 2015**, at the EBRPD Administrative Office, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 3:15 p.m.

***Depart Peralta Oaks** **10:00 a.m.**
(Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than **9:45 a.m.**)

From Peralta Oaks, take I-580 W towards Emeryville. Follow I-80 E / I-580 W to the Point Richmond-San Rafael split. Take I-580 to the Point Richmond/Richmond Parkway Exit. Exit at the Richmond Parkway and turn right onto Richmond Parkway. In about 3.8 miles, turn left onto Goodrick Avenue and drive to the end, parking in the flat area past the gate. We may be walking for 10-15 minutes out to the marsh.

Arrive at Breuner Marsh **10:45 a.m.**
The Board will be touring the restored Breuner Marsh and hear from Chris Barton, Project Manager.

From Goodrick Avenue, turn left onto the Richmond Parkway. Exit at Giant Highway. Turn right at the stop light, over the railroad tracks to continue right onto Giant Highway. Turn left into the Point Pinole Regional Shoreline at 5551 Giant Highway. Any personal vehicles must be parked in the parking lot before proceeding into the park. Anyone from the public will need to board a District vehicle at the parking lot or walk into the park. District vehicles will follow the guide vehicle across Badger Bridge and park on the shoulder of the road to walk a short distance to view the marsh.

Point Pinole **11:45 a.m.**
The Board will be viewing the restored Breuner Marsh from the Badger Bridge area.

Follow the guide vehicle to the group camp area.

Point Pinole Group Camp (Lunch)** **12:15 p.m.**
The Board will have lunch at the Point Pinole Group Camp.

After lunch, follow the guide vehicle to a place to park near the pier or you may walk to the pier.

Fishing Pier

1:00 p.m.

The Board will walk to the fishing pier to hear from Zenaida Trinidad, District Planning staff member, about upcoming pier furnishing improvements.

Follow the guide vehicle to the Atlas Bridge building site.

Atlas Bridge

1:45 p.m.

The Board will visit the future Atlas Bridge building site to hear from Audrey Som and Glenn Gilchrist about the bridge progress, new service yard and future Visitor Center.

Follow the guide vehicle back to the parking lot, drop off any members of the public and drive back to Peralta Oaks.
