2000 - Public Safety acquires 1989 Fleetwood Motorhome from Oakland Fire Department.

2003 - Mobile Incident Command Vehicle is completely refurbished and available for deployment

2009 - Overall status of Mobile Incident Command Vehicle has deteriorated to a point where it becomes unusable

2013 - Board approves moving forward with replacement

2016 - RFP Process and selection of vendor

2017 - Delivery of New Mobile Incident Command Vehicle
