Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than **8:30 a.m.** It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 3:00 p.m.

Depart Peralta Oaks Headquarters **9:00 a.m.**
Directions to Coyote Hills Regional Park located at 8000 Patterson Ranch Road, Fremont.

From Peralta Oaks Drive turn left onto 106th Ave → Turn left onto Foothill Blvd → Left onto MacArthur Blvd → Take the onramp onto I-580 East toward Hayward → Take the Highway 238 exit toward I-880 South → Proceed I-880 South approximately 4.6 miles → Take the Decoto Road/Dumbarton Bridge exit onto Highway 84 West → Exit onto Paseo Padre Parkway and turn right → Turn left onto Patterson Ranch Road → Continue through the park kiosk and follow road to the end and park at the Coyote Hills Visitor Center Parking Area.

Arrive at Coyote Hills Visitor Center **10:00 a.m.**
The group will assemble in front of the Visitor Center where Regional Interpretive & Recreation Services Manager David Zuckermann and Supervising Naturalist Sonja Gomez will provide an overview of the park's Interpretive Services and provide a tour of the Visitor Center. District Architect Jim Devlin will provide an update on the upcoming Visitor Center Feasibility Study.

Interpretive Program Observation **10:30 a.m.**
Beginning at the Visitor Center, the group will observe an elementary school program in session. Supervising Naturalist Sonja Gomez will lead an Ohlone Cultural and Village Site Program for a local 3rd grade class. The program will include a walk of 0.6 miles to the Ohlone Village Site.

Return to Coyote Hills Visitor Center **11:40 a.m.**
The group will be transported by District vehicles to the Visitor Center for lunch.

Lunch at Coyote Hills Visitor Center Nectar Garden **11:45 a.m.**
Lunch not provided to the public. Members of the public please bring your bag lunch. Beverages will be provided.

Travel to Patterson Property**12:30 p.m.**

From the Coyote Hills Visitor Center parking area → Follow Patterson Ranch Road to the fire road gate past the kiosk on the left → Proceed through the gate and park in the open area.

Arrive at Patterson Property**12:40p.m.**

The Board will tour areas of the Patterson Property and be provided updates on the Coyote Hills Land Use Plan Amendment and Park Development Plan. Environmental Programs Manager Chris Barton will be providing updates.

Travel to Dumbarton Quarry Overlook**1:15 p.m.**

From Patterson Ranch Road drive East to Paseo Padre Parkway intersection → Take a right turn onto Paseo Padre Parkway → Proceed 1.9 miles to Marshlands Road → Make a right turn onto Marshlands Road → Proceed approximately 0.9 miles passing Don Edwards Visitor Center → Make a right turn onto Quarry Trail → Proceed left onto Apay Way Trail approximately 0.1 mile over the pedestrian bridge to the Quarry Overlook site.

Non-District vehicles will need to park at Don Edwards Visitor Center and carpool in a District vehicle to the overlook site.

Arrive at Dumbarton Quarry Overlook**1:30 p.m.**

The Board will view the Dumbarton Quarry Project from the overlook site. District Landscape Architect Kim Fisher will provide updates on the project.

Travel to Peralta Oaks**2:00 p.m.**

Return to Marshlands Road → Proceed .9 miles to Thornton Avenue intersection → Turn left and proceed to Highway 84 → Turn right onto Highway 84 East towards I-880 → Take I-880 North towards Oakland → Proceed to Highway 238 → Take Highway 238 North → Exit onto I-580 West → Follow I-580 and exit onto Foothill Boulevard following to 106th Avenue → Turn right onto 106th Avenue → Turn right onto Peralta Oaks Drive → Turn left onto Peralta Oaks Court.
