For those joining the Board Site Tour and departing from EBRPD Headquarters, please arrive no later than **8:30 a.m.** It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 3:00 p.m.

### **Depart Peralta Oaks Headquarters 9:00 a.m.**

From Park District headquarters, head southwest on Peralta Oaks Court towards Peralta Oaks Drive and turn right. Proceed straight and merge onto I-580 West via the ramp to Downtown Oakland/San Francisco. Continue on I-580 West. Keep right at the fork to continue on CA-13 North, follow signs for Berkeley. Take exit 5C to merge onto CA-24 East towards Walnut Creek/Concord. Keep right at the fork to remain on CA-24 East. After the tunnel, take exit 7A on the right toward Fish Ranch Road. Take Fish Ranch Road to Grizzly Peak Blvd and turn right. Continue on Grizzly Peak Boulevard until you reach the intersection of Spruce Street, Wildcat Canyon Road and Canon Drive. Turn right on Wildcat Canyon Rd, then an immediate sharp left down Canon Drive. At the bottom of the hill, veer left onto Central Park Drive and follow into the parking lot for the Nature Area.

### **Arrive at Tilden Environmental Education Center (EEC) 10:00 a.m.**

The group will meet at the Environmental Education Center for a brief overview of the day. Restrooms available at this stop.

### **Tour Sediment Basin Excavation and Pond Restoration Project and Jewel Lake 10:15 a.m.**

The Park District Stewardship Fisheries Manager Joe Sullivan and Landscape Architect Carmen Erasmus will lead a tour of recently completed projects to restore several interpretive ponds and to provide more continuous water flow to Jewel Lake. The group will also visit Jewel Lake and discuss plans. The tour will include a walk of 0.6 miles.

**Return to Tilden Environmental Education Center (EEC)** **11:30 a.m.**

**Lunch at Tilden Environmental Education Center** **12:00 p.m.**

During the lunch hour, Public Affairs Assistant General Manager Carol Johnson, Regional Parks Foundation (RPF) Development Director Juliana Schirmer and RPF Board members will provide a brief presentation and lead a discussion about their interests in pursuing a capital campaign in support of Tilden's visitor center.

**Depart Tilden Nature Area for Lake Anza Parking Lot** **1:00 p.m.**

From the parking lot, follow Central Park Drive uphill. Look for signs for Lake Anza. Turn left onto Lake Anza Road and follow to the right all the way to Lake Anza parking lot.

**Arrive at Lake Anza Parking Lot** **1:15 p.m.**

The Park District Stewardship Integrated Pest Management Specialist Casey Brierley and Project Manager Toby Perry will provide an overview of the upcoming oxygenation project for control of cyanobacteria in Lake Anza at Tilden. Additionally, Stewardship staff will be discussing cyanobacteria issues District-wide.

**Depart for Park District Headquarters** **2:00 p.m.**

Follow Lake Anza Road and turn left onto Central Park Drive. Turn right on Shasta Road. Take a sharp left onto Golf Course Road. Turn left onto Golf Course Road. Turn left onto Grizzly Peak Blvd. Turn left onto Fish Ranch Road. Turn left before the overpass to reach the freeway entrance. Merge onto CA-24 West. Take exit 5A for Hayward toward CA-13 South. Continue on CA-13 South. Merge onto I-580 East. Take exit 29B for Foothill Blvd/106<sup>th</sup> Ave. Turn left off the freeway exit. Turn left onto Foothill Blvd. Turn left at the light, 106<sup>th</sup> Ave. Turn right at Peralta Oaks Drive. Turn left onto Peralta Oaks Court.
