Trail Description

This trail in easternmost Contra Costa County winds along Marsh Creek through bountiful tracts of farmland. When completed, the trail will be approximately 14 miles long and will connect the fertile Delta region to the quiet serenity of Round Valley Regional Park east of Mt. Diablo State Park. Trail users can access several community parks and greenbelts along the way which offer respite from mid-day summer heat.
