EXAMPLES OF PAC TASKS

Below are examples of PAC action items:

MASTER PLAN:
Makes recommendations on the 1973 Master Plan, the 1989 Master Plan, the 1997 Master Plan and the 2013 Master Plan;
Reviews all undedicated parklands and regional trails for consideration for dedication by the Board.
BOARD REQUESTS:
Reviews the structure of new concessions and special use proposals.
Reviews the external audit and management letter and the Budget (through the Finance Subcommittee);
Reviews use problems relating to policy, such as multiuse (bicyclists, equestrians, hikers) trail issues;
Reviews new policies such as the Cultural Diversity and the Bicycle Policy.
FROM PAC MEMBERS:
Raises issues related to Master Plan policies such as an inconsistent activity.
Raises issues of general policy concern such as dog impacts on parks.
