

EXAMPLES OF PAC TASKS

Below are examples of PAC action items:

MASTER PLAN:

- Makes recommendations on the 1973 Master Plan, the 1989 Master Plan, the 1997 Master Plan and the 2013 Master Plan;
- Reviews all undedicated parklands and regional trails for consideration for dedication by the Board.

BOARD REQUESTS:

- Reviews the structure of new concessions and special use proposals.
- Reviews the external audit and management letter and the Budget (through the Finance Subcommittee);
- Reviews use problems relating to policy, such as multiuse (bicyclists, equestrians, hikers) trail issues;
- Reviews new policies such as the Cultural Diversity and the Bicycle Policy.

FROM PAC MEMBERS:

- Raises issues related to Master Plan policies such as an inconsistent activity.
- Raises issues of general policy concern such as dog impacts on parks.
