Trail Length 0.9 mi (1.5 km)

Network trail

This trail starts in an accessible parking lot and leads out to the bay. It has beautiful views of the bay on one side and a duck pond on the other. This trail has easy grades throughout and would be a good trail for users of all ability levels.

Elevation Change Loss 17 ft (5 m)

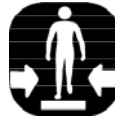
