Fire Dept. Recommended Treatment Type(s): Cut and spray brush, remove pines, and thin oaks and bays. Create a 200 foot buffer of grassland above homes.

Stewardship Preferred Treatment Type(s): Reduce density of coastal scrub by removing French Broom and decreasing cover of coyote brush in favor of Mimulus and sage. Hand treatment. Support & guide community actions


