Network trail

While hiking up a somewhat steep hill you will enjoy the company of hawks and ground squirrels. The trail is not very shaded, however this gives way to panoramic views of the Sunol hills.

Cumulative Gain 540ft (165 m)
Elevation Change Loss 17 ft (5m)

This trailhead starts off Geary Road, right next to the visitor center. You will cross the bridge and make a right. The trail will be on the left hand side.
