**SUBJECT: Review of Redwood Bowmen Special Use Agreement:
Roberts Regional Recreation Area**

The Redwood Bowmen, a non-profit archery club, have operated an archery range in Redwood Bowl since 1941. At that time, the site was considered temporary but the 1977 Land Use Plan, EIR, determined that an archery regional center was beneficial to the District and the community. The current site accommodates an archery regional center; it has the level of archery activity and the site requirements include the following features: permanency, large parking capability (min. 75 cars), good public access, availability of utilities, range house, storage, flat space for field marksmanship (1-2 acres), varied, wooded terrain for roving archery (20 acres), and security for facilities.

The area consists of three separate 14-target courses; the Open Course, the Lower Course, and the Hill Course. Each 14-target course is about a half mile in distance. The ranges are located in the redwood forest on the west slope of Redwood Peak and in an area of brush land to the north. A meadow between the clubhouse and Redwood Bowl is irrigated and used as a practice range. The Redwood Bowmen built the clubhouse and ranges, and maintain them with help from the District for brush clearing. Parking is available at the neighboring Chabot Science Center.

The range has a convenient access from the parking area at Chabot Science Center and is open to the public. The range is popular in the East Bay area and has an average rating of 4.8 of 5 stars on YELP and Facebook. The club holds a meet once a month and closes to the public during the event. An introduction to archery class is taught by Redwood Bowmen club members through the District's Recreation Program. Topics covered include recreational archery, safety and terminology followed by hands-on practice out on the range.

A Special Use Agreement with a current District standard of a 5-year term with a 5-year term extension, to be agreed by both parties, is recommended by staff. In addition, staff recommends the fee increase to \$1,200 per year to align with the standard Special Use Fee.
