## FIELD TRIP BOARD OF DIRECTORS

### AGENDA

The field trip below has been scheduled for the East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors, and will commence at 9:30 a.m. on **Thursday, August 4, 2016**, at EBRPD Administrative Office, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 3:00 p.m.

**\*Depart Peralta Oaks** 9:30 a.m.  
(Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than **9:15 a.m.**)

From Peralta Oaks, take I-580 W towards Emeryville. Follow I-80/I-580 W to the Point Richmond-San Rafael split. Exit at Richmond Parkway/Castro Street and continue about 5 miles on Richmond Parkway. Exit at Giant Highway and turn right. Turn right again after the railroad tracks. The park entrance will be on the left at 555 I Giant Highway, Richmond 94806.

**Arrive at Atlas Road Bridge** 10:15 a.m.  
The Board will be viewing the construction on the Atlas Road Bridge and hear from Glenn Gilchrist, Design Manager, Design & Construction Department

From the Atlas Road Bridge, walk to the adjacent flagged location of potential Visitor Center, Site #1.

**Point Pinole - Site #1, Visitor Center** 10:45 a.m.  
The Board will be viewing Site #1, a proposed option for future Visitor Center and hear from the project manager Jim Devlin, Architect, Design & Construction Department & Architectural Consultants

Follow the guide vehicle to the flagged location of Site #2, a distance of approximately 0.25 miles.

**Point Pinole – Site #2, Visitor Center** 11:15 a.m.  
The Board will be viewing Site #1, a proposed option for future Visitor Center and hear from the project manager Jim Devlin, Architect, Design & Construction Department & Architectural Consultants

Follow the guide vehicle to flagged location Site #3, a distance of approximately 0.17 miles.

**Point Pinole – Site #3, Visitor Center**

11:40 a.m.

The Board will be viewing Site #1, a proposed option for future Visitor Center and hear from the project manager Jim Devlin, Architect, Design & Construction Department & Architectural Consultants

Walk to the adjacent Shoreline Picnic Area.

**Point Pinole Shoreline Picnic Area (Lunch\*\*)**

12:00 noon

The Board will have lunch at the Shoreline Picnic Area.

After lunch, drive to Breuner Marsh. From Point Pinole turn right on to Giant Highway. Turn left over the railroad tracks and left at the traffic light, heading toward Richmond Parkway. Take the Richmond Parkway East ramp, merging on to the Richmond Parkway. Take the first right on to Goodrick Avenue. Continue to the end of Goodrick Avenue to enter Breuner Marsh, 2.5 miles from the Point Pinole entrance.

**Breuner Marsh (\*\*\*This portion may be cancelled due to construction)**

1:10 p.m.

The Board will be viewing the construction site at Breuner Marsh and will hear from Chris Barton, Environmental Programs Manager

Follow the guide vehicle back to the parking lot, drop off any members of the public and drive back to Peralta Oaks.
