The field trip below has been scheduled for the East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors, and will commence at 10:00 a.m. on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 4</u>, <u>2015</u>, at the EBRPD Administrative Office, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 3:15 p.m.

Depart Peralta Oaks 10:00 a.m.

(Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than 9:45 a.m.)

Directions to Coyote Hills Regional Park, 8000 Patterson Ranch Road, Fremont: From Peralta Oaks Drive, turn left onto 106th Ave. Turn left onto Foothill Blvd., then left onto MacArthur Blvd. Take the ramp onto I-580 East toward Hayward. Then take Hwy. 238 exit toward I-880 south. In Fremont, take the Decoto Rd./Dumbarton Bridge exit onto Hwy 84 west. Take the Paseo Padre Parkway exit. Turn right on Paseo Padre Parkway, then left to Patterson Ranch Road. Continue through the park kiosk. Turn left into the Quarry Staging Area to meet the Guide Vehicle.

Arrive at Coyote Hills 10:45 a.m.

The Board will be viewing the Patterson Ranch Property and Dumbarton Quarry Campground guided by Matt McDonell, Park Supervisor.

The tour will be conducted by vehicle. Personal vehicles must be parked in the parking lot before proceeding into the park in District Vehicles. Anyone from the public will need to board a District vehicle at the parking lot or walk into the park. District vehicles will follow the guide vehicle to the viewing area.

Patterson Ranch Property

II:00 a.m.

The Board will be viewing the Patterson Ranch Property with emphasis on the Alameda County Flood Control P-Line Restoration Project.

From the Quarry Staging Area, District vehicles will follow the guide vehicle on Bay View Trail and Upper Meadowlark Trail and park on the shoulder of the road to view the property.

Travel to Dumbarton Quarry Overlook

11:15 a.m.

The group will travel back Upper Meadowlark Trail and then turn left onto Apay Way and travel approximately 1.25 miles to the Dumbarton Quarry Overlook.

Follow the guide vehicle to a place to park near the Quarry.

Milk House I:30 p.m.

The Board will view the new Milk House exhibit depicting food preservation techniques of the mid- to late-1800s and hear from Sara Fetterly, Acting Supervising Naturalist and David Edquist, Exhibit Design Supervisor.

Historic Wheat Harvesting 2:00 p.m.

The Board will view a demonstration of the historic wheat harvesting and threshing program presented each July at Ardenwood.
