The group will return to the MOTC parking lot at 12:30 PM and those returning back to Peralta Oaks will arrive at approximately 1:30 PM.

From Highway 680 – Take Highway 242 to Port Chicago Highway, exit Port Chicago Highway to the North. Travel approximately 0.5 miles north past the Diablo Creek Golf Course. The Military Ocean Terminal Concord is marked by a large sign and will be located on the right just before the town of Clyde. Park in the parking lot labeled for visitors.

From Highway 4 – exit Port Chicago Highway and head north of Highway 4. Travel approximately 0.5 miles north past the Diablo Creek Golf Course. The Military Ocean Terminal Concord is marked by a large sign and will be located on the right just before the town of Clyde. Park in the parking lot labeled for visitors.

**Arrive at Concord Naval Weapons Station 10:00 AM**
