The field trip below has been scheduled for the East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors, and will commence at 9:00 a.m. on **Monday, June 30, 2014**, at the EBRPD Administrative Office, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 3:15 p.m.

***Depart Peralta Oaks** **9:00 a.m.**
(Anyone planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks should arrive no later than **8:45 a.m.**)

Brickyard Area, McLaughlin Eastshore State Park **9:30 a.m.**
The Board will visit the Brickyard area and view the site of future development.
Take Hwy 580 W toward Berkeley. Merge onto Hwy 880/580 toward Berkeley/Sacramento and take the first exit, Powell St. Emeryville. Turn left onto Powell St. and then right onto Frontage Rd. Proceed two miles north to the Seabreeze Market at University Ave. Park inside the gates next to the large soil pile.

Berkeley Meadow **10:30 a.m.**
The Board will walk to the observation area of Berkeley Meadow for a presentation on the three phases of restoration.
From Sea Breeze Market and Deli parking lot, turn left (west) onto University Ave. Then turn right onto Marina Blvd. The parking area is on the east side of Marina Blvd. next to the trailhead.

Virginia Street Extension and North Basin Strip **11:15 a.m.**
The Board will drive on the Virginia St. Extension and North Basin Strip to see the Schoolhouse Creek outfall.
Drive north on Marina Blvd. and turn right onto the Virginia St. Extension. Continue around the North Basin Strip.

Albany Beach **11:30 a.m.**
The Board will proceed to the Albany Beach area for a presentation from staff on Environmental Programs projects on the Albany Neck and Albany Beach. They will have lunch at the site of a proposed picnic area.
Drive north on Frontage Rd. and turn left onto Gilman St. Turn right behind Golden Gate Fields to Albany Beach.

Tour of the Albany Plateau **12:45 p.m.**
Leaving Albany Beach, the Board will drive on the Albany Plateau for a loop around the Burrowing Owl Enclosure.
Drive north through the gate and turn right onto Buchanan St. Turn left at the portable building and go through the pipe-gate leading onto the Albany Plateau.
