Driving Directions from I-880 in Oakland

Take the 66th Avenue exit. At 66th Avenue, turn west toward the bay. 66th Avenue ends at Oakport Street. Turn right onto Oakport Street and drive about a quarter-mile following the MLK Day Cleanup directional signs. The signs will direct you to turn left onto a dirt road to reach the parking area.
