ADOPTION OF CEQA GUIDELINES

WHEREAS, the District adopted an Environmental Review Manual establishing Guidelines and Procedures for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA) and the Board has subsequently approved revisions to the Manual as amendments to CEQA are approved by the State; and

WHEREAS, the last revision of the Manual was approved by the Board by Resolution No. 1984-5-125 dated June 21, 1984, and as further amendments to the Act have been made by the State, the General Manager recommends revision and updating of the Environmental Review Guidelines to bring the District into conformance with State CEQA Guidelines and Federal law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Environmental Review Manual, as revised and presented to the Board this date, is hereby adopted as the District's Guidelines and Procedures for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (as amended through January 1, 1986).
