STUDENT LABORER

GENERAL FUNCTION

Under supervision, to perform non-skilled labor in the parks.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Performs various unskilled manual tasks needed in parks, for example: Collects litter, sweeps paths and parking lots, cleans toilet buildings, loads debris for pick up, etc. May perform various unskilled general tasks related to the operation of the park buildings, for example: Unloads supplies, empties wastebaskets, and performs general clean up. This is a general labor position that may be called upon to do any labor task that does not require training or experience; may operate a District vehicle or utility cart, but will not operate other machinery (electric, battery, or gas), or power equipment, and uses a variety of hand tools and cleaning supplies.

OTHER FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

May perform other duties as assigned- and assist other employees with park projects.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education: Equivalent to completion of the tenth grade, and 15 ½ years to 20 years of age at the close of recruitment. Must be in attendance at, or on legitimate leave from, a high school, trade school, college or university, and must be enrolled in at least one course for the upcoming semester.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES

Ability to do manual labor. Ability to follow directions. Ability to establish and maintain positive working relationships with those contacted in the course of work at all levels, including a culturally diverse public, with a focus on quality service to internal and external customers.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

A Student Laborer:

- is required to wear a prescribed uniform;
- is required to work outdoors in all types of inclement weather;
- may be required to work irregular hours, including weekends and holidays as needed;
- may be required to possess a valid California driver's license; this is required in order to drive a District vehicle or utility cart.
