Slope Repairs to Begin on Carquinez Scenic Drive

Full Road Closure in Effect May 26 through June 30

As soon as May 26, a contractor for the Contra Costa Water District will begin making slope repairs along Carquinez Scenic Drive between Canyon Lake Drive and McEwen Road. Slope repairs are necessary to ensure the integrity of the hillside. **The project is expected to begin May 26 and be complete June 30. This portion of Carquinez Scenic Drive will be closed for the duration of the project and traffic will be rerouted to adjacent streets.** See other side of this notice for details.

Several months ago, the Contra Costa Water District replaced the pipeline that connects the Port Costa Reservoir to the system in Port Costa in response to a leak that developed following the August 2014 earthquake. The current dry weather provides a window of opportunity to complete the necessary slope repairs located downhill from the reservoir.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions while work is underway. Work hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Weekend and evening work is not anticipated, but may become necessary to keep the project on schedule.


During work hours, you can expect to hear construction-related noise in your neighborhood and notice construction-related traffic in the general area.

What Can You Expect?

- Slope restoration will occur on Carquinez Scenic Drive between Canyon Lake Drive and McEwen Road.
- Carquinez Scenic Drive will remain closed to traffic through completion of the slide repairs, currently anticipated by June 30.
- Water service is not expected to be interrupted during the slope repair work.
