SANITATION TRUCK DRIVER

GENERAL FUNCTION:

Under supervision, drives large sanitation pump-out trucks on rounds throughout the regional parks and performs related site labor to collect and dispose of sewage from chemical toilets, tanks and septic tanks.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

The Sanitation Truck Driver drives on city streets, highways, maintained park roads, fire roads, and semi-maintained park accesses to properly collect and dispose of sewage and garbage and to clean and stock chemical toilets. The Sanitation Truck Driver is responsible for keeping tank trucks clean and in proper operating condition, which includes arranging for scheduled and emergency service and making emergency repairs for in-field breakdowns. The Sanitation Truck Driver keeps records and tallies, makes reports, and performs minor administrative work as required to document tasks done. May serve as a lead person to helper position. Performs related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education: Equivalent to completion of twelfth grade; and
- Experience: Three years of recent experience in operating a variety of large trucks.
- Licenses: A currently effective and valid Class B California driver's license with tank and airbrake endorsement, and no restrictions, is a condition of initial and continued employment in this classification.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

General knowledge of sewage and garbage collection and disposal techniques. General mechanical skills for operating and keeping a variety of equipment in safe operating condition. Ability to safely drive large equipment, at times under hazardous driving conditions. Ability to work conscientiously alone. Ability to communicate effectively using a radio. Ability to establish and maintain positive and cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work at all levels, including a culturally diverse general public, with a focus on quality service to internal staff and external customers and park users.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Willingness to work in adverse conditions. Willingness to work weekends, holidays, and long hours beyond a normal shift, if special circumstances require it.
