


When to Use


This page type is used for creating a link within the dynamic site navigation section or the child pages list that opens a Digital Asset (image, word document, PDF file, etc.).

Examples of when to use

- ▶ To provide a link to a project report in PDF format within your site navigation.
- ▶ To provide a links to a list of maps in image formats within a child list.

Attachment Page Sections & Fields

<i>Page Section</i>	<i>Field Name/Item</i>	<i>Description of usage</i>
Link Properties	Attachment	The name of the document to be opened when the user clicks on the attachment link.
	<<Select Digital Asset>>	Click here to select a file from the Digital Asset library.
	Open in New Window	Check to make the document open in a new browser window.
	Display Attachment Icon	Displays document-type icon to the right of the attachment link. 
	Display Attachment Size	In the illustration above, 27KB is the size of the document.
	Display Attachment Type	In the illustration above, the word DOC indicates the type of attachment you have linked to.
	Enter path to popup content	To add a popup to the attachment Type , you can enter a path to a file on your server OR add text in the editor window. For example: if you attach a PDF file and the Attachment Type checkbox is checked, the user can click on the word PDF (attachment type link) to display a popup window. This allows you to provide additional information about the attached content such as requiring the Adobe Acrobat Reader for PDF files, and including a link to download it.

Attachment Page Tips!

- ▶ To display attachment links in the content area of the page, the page template must contain the correct IronPoint tag. See the *Design Guide* for more information.
- ▶ To display links in the navigation section of your page, you must ensure the Site Design Manager settings for the parent page are set to include children in the site navigation.
- ▶ To change the attached Digital Asset: Edit the page and click on the filename link beside the **Attachment** field and select a new digital asset from the library. Remember that the link text displayed on the published page is the same as the Attachment page's Title field. You may need to edit the title if you change the attachment file.
