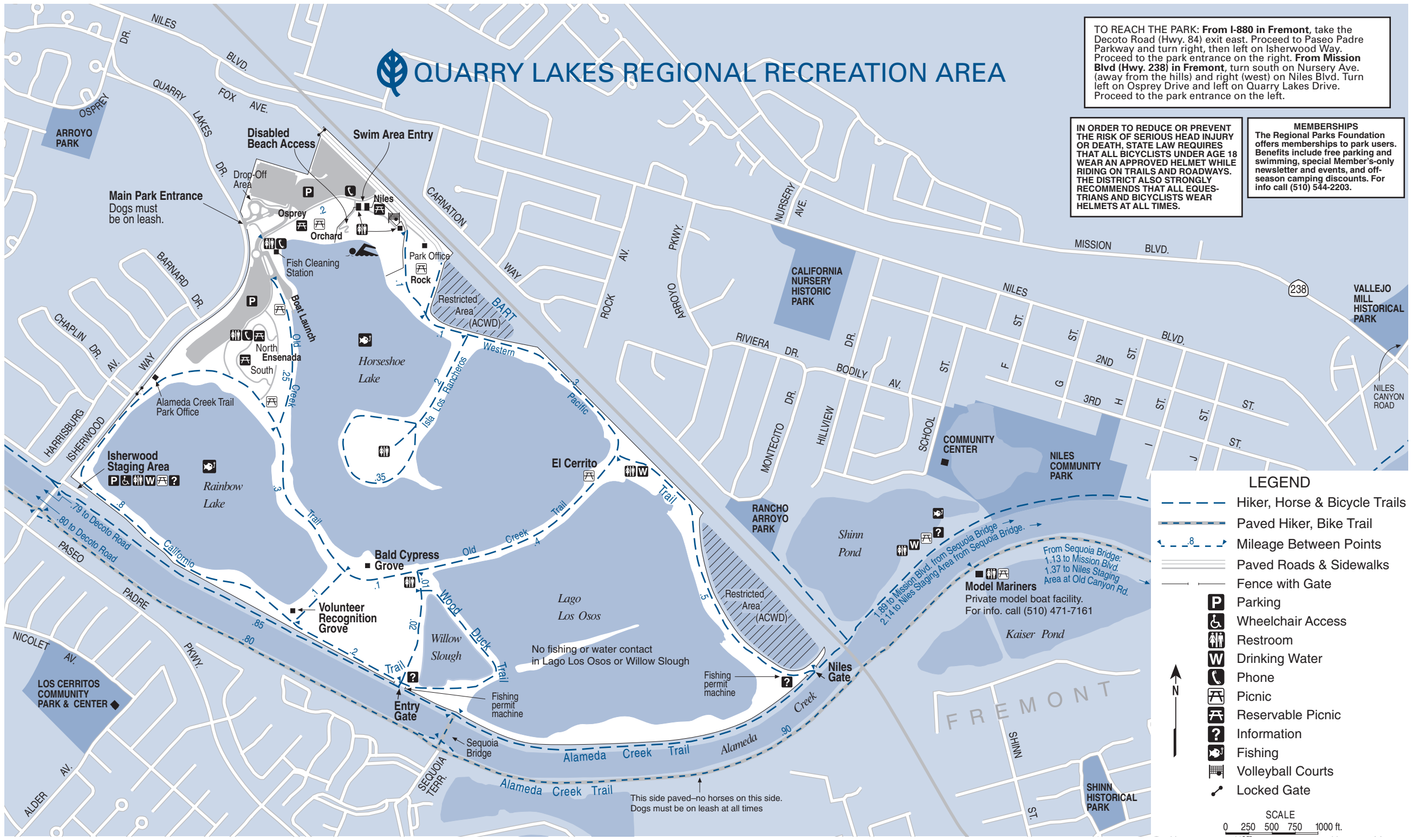


QUARRY LAKES REGIONAL RECREATION AREA

TO REACH THE PARK: From I-880 in Fremont, take the Decoto Road (Hwy. 84) exit east. Proceed to Paseo Padre Parkway and turn right, then left on Isherwood Way. Proceed to the park entrance on the right. **From Mission Blvd (Hwy. 238) in Fremont,** turn south on Nursery Ave. (away from the hills) and right (west) on Niles Blvd. Turn left on Osprey Drive and left on Quarry Lakes Drive. Proceed to the park entrance on the left.
