The plants are grouped according to their scientific family name for easy accessibility. The common family name is listed immediately to the right of the scientific version.

The plants within each family are listed alphabetically by scientific name. Other information on each plant includes the common name, growth form, whether the plant is native or introduced, and its longevity.

For quick reference, the upper left corner of each page displays both the group name (based on growth form) and the genus of the first scientific name.
