Anyone joining the trip should arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. It is anticipated the group will return at approximately 3:00 p.m.

Depart Peralta Oaks 9:00 a.m.

From Peralta Oaks turn right on Peralta Oaks Drive, and merge onto I-580 West via the onramp. Travel 3 miles and merge onto Highway 13/Warren Fwy, North, signs for Berkeley. After 5.4 miles, take exit 5C to merge on to CA-24 East toward Walnut Creek/Concord. Keep left at the fork to stay on CA-24 East, follow signs for Walnut Creek/Concord. Take exit 9 toward Orinda/Moraga. Use any lane to turn left onto Camino Pablo. In 0.2 miles, continue straight to stay on Camino Pablo. In 2 miles, Turn right Bear Creek Rd/Wildcat Canyon Rd. In 4.4 miles, turn right into Bear Creek Staging Area (16 Bear Creek Rd.)

Arrive at Bear Creek Staging Area, Briones Regional Park 9:45 a.m.

The group will assemble in the staging area parking lot to the right, adjacent to Newt Hollow Picnic Area.

Depart Bear Creek Staging Area in "All Wheel Drive" District Vehicles 10:00 a.m.

Arrive at top of Seaborg Trail 10:15 a.m.

PG&E Pipeline Safety Initiative Tree Removal Project: Overview of the proposed tree removal for the Pipeline Safety Initiative. A discussion of which trees were determined for removal to protect the PG&E gas line and how negotiations protected over 300 trees that were initially slated for removal. A driving tour to view trees will follow nearly 5 miles of the pipeline through the park.

Arrive at Briones Orchard 1:15 p.m.

Hike the Vaca Creek Trail (approx. 3/4 mile), the future trail connection to the Bay Area Ridge Trail. District Trails Development Program Manager Sean Dougan will discuss future trail connections with the John Muir Land Trust and National Park Service Mt. Wanda.

Depart Briones Orchard return to Peralta Oaks Office 2:30 p.m.

Turn right on Alhambra Valley Road, keep straight onto Relize Valley Road, turn left on Grayson Road, in .5 miles turn right onto Taylor Blvd., in 3.7 miles take Highway 24 west onramp, in 8.9 miles take exit Highway 13 South then take I-580 East towards Hayward/Stockton. Exit 106th/Foothill Blvd, make immediate left onto Foothill Blvd, then left at stoplight onto 106th. Turn right onto Peralta Oaks Drive then left on Peralta Oaks Court.
