RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT AB 1918 (GARCIA D-COACHELLA) – OFFICE OF

WHEREAS, AB 1918 seeks to engage the outdoor industry in legislative matters through the creation of an Office of Sustainable Outdoor Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is home to multiple outdoor industry headquarters including The North Face in Alameda and Mountain Hardwear in Richmond; and

WHEREAS, similar offices exist in Utah, Washington and Colorado and have demonstrated benefits in assisting the outdoor industry and supporting recreation; and

WHEREAS, the East Bay Regional Park District's mission would benefit from more involvement by the Outdoor Industry Association in Sacramento.
