RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT AB 2441 - SACRAMENTO-SAN JOAQUIN DELTA
ABANDONED VESSEL REMOVAL ACCOUNT (FRAZIER D-DISCOVERY BAY)

WHEREAS, this legislation would create an account in the General Fund to make funds available for the removal of abandoned commercial vessels in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta; and

WHEREAS, abandoned vessels in the Delta are more common than they should be, and are both environmental and visually problematic; and

WHEREAS, the District's Big Break Regional Shoreline is 85% water with approximately 1,400 acres submerged; and

WHEREAS, the District's Master Plan also envisions a Delta Access park with some of its acreage being submerged; and

WHEREAS, abandoned vessels are expensive and challenging to remove; and

WHEREAS, AB 2441 could provide assistance to address this environmental and visual challenge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Directors of the East Bay Regional Park District hereby support AB 2441 - Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Abandoned Vessel Removal Account (Frazier D-Discovery Bay); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the General Manager is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the District and in its name, to execute and deliver such documents, and to do such acts as may be deemed necessary or appropriate to accomplish the intentions of this resolution.
