Accommodation will be made for visitors with disabilities upon advance request.





OHONE VILLAGE SITE TOUR

10-noon & 1:30-3:30pm, Sunday, November 11

Walk one-half mile through vibrant marsh habitat to a more than 2,000 years old Ohlone village site. Learn about Ohlone cultures, past to present. Tour a reconstructed shade structure, pit house and sweat house. Meet at the Visitor Center.

OHONE VILLAGE SITE OPEN HOUSE

Tour a reconstructed shade structure, pit house, and sweat house, built on a more-than 2,000 years old Ohlone village site. Walk through at your own pace or meet up with staff to learn about Ohlone cultures, past to present. Meet at the Tuibun Village Site.
