Depart Peralta Oaks Headquarters 9:00 a.m.

From Peralta Oaks, take I-580 West to I-980 West and exit at 12th Street (exit #1C). Go straight onto Brush Street and turn left on 5th Street. At Broadway make a slight left towards Alameda through the Webster Street Tube. Continue to the end of Webster Street and make a right turn onto Central Avenue. Make a left turn onto McKay Avenue and follow to parking area on the left before the Crab Cove Visitor Center.

Arrive at Crab Cove Visitor Center 10:00 a.m.

Beginning at the Visitor Center, the group will briefly observe an interpretive pre-school program. Regional Interpretive & Recreation Services Manager David Zuckerman and Supervising Naturalist James Frank will provide an overview of the park's interpretive services and lead a tour of the facility including the recently renovated lab classroom spaces. Park District Architect Jim Devlin will highlight the building's renovation process.

Arrive at McKay Avenue/GSA Property 11:15 a.m.

The group will walk over to the GSA property site for a brief tour and will hear planning and design updates from Park District Planning Chief Brian Holt and Capital Program Manager Ren Bates.

Lunch at Crown Beach – Neptune Picnic Area 12:00 p.m.

Depart to Encinal Beach 12:45 p.m.
