Attendees departing from EBRPD Headquarters should arrive no later than **8:30 a.m.** It is anticipated that the group will return by approximately 1:10 p.m.

Depart Peralta Oaks Headquarters 9:00 a.m.

From Peralta Oaks turn right on Peralta Oaks Drive, turn left on 106th Avenue, turn left onto Foothill Blvd., turn left onto Macarthur Blvd., and merge onto I-580 E via the ramp on the left. Follow I-580 East and merge onto I-680 North, continue on I-680 North to the El Cerro exit in Danville, take exit #40 and turn left onto El Cerro Blvd. Follow El Cerro Blvd. and turn right onto Danville Blvd. Continue on Danville Blvd approximately 6 miles and turn left onto Camille Ave. Continue approximately 0.4 miles on Camille Ave. Parking is where available on the public street.

Arrive at the Camille Lane Trailhead 9:45 a.m.

The Board will assemble and hear a brief presentation from Principal Planner Devan Reiff on a local development proposal and potential staging area at this location.

Depart for the Podva Trailhead 10:05 a.m.

From Camille Ln. turn right onto Danville Blvd. continue approximately 1.3 miles and turn right onto Railroad Ave. Follow Railroad Ave. approximately 0.6 miles and turn right onto San Ramon Valley Blvd. Continue on San Ramon Valley Blvd. approximately 1.0 mile and turn right onto Midland Way. Continue approximately 0.25 miles to the end of Midland Way and turn right onto Red Tail Ct. Parking is where available on the public street.

Arrive at the Podva Trailhead 10:20 a.m.

The Board will assemble and hear a brief presentation from Principal Planner Neoma Lavalley on the recently completed trail access and dedication of open space.

Depart for the Elworthy Staging Area 10:40 a.m.

From Red Tail Ct. turn left onto Midland Way, continue approximately 0.25 miles and turn right onto San Ramon Valley Blvd. Continue on San Ramon Valley Blvd. approximately 0.4 miles, then turn right onto Elworthy Ranch

Rd. After 200 feet, turn left onto Elworthy Ranch Dr. Continue 250 feet and turn right onto Elworthy Ranch Circle, continue for 250 feet and turn right onto the entrance for the Elworthy Staging Area. Parking is available at the top of the entrance road.

Arrive at the Elworthy Staging Area **10:50 a.m.**

The Board will assemble and hear a brief presentation from Principal Planner Neoma Lavelle on how the Elworthy Staging Area is incorporated into the Southern Las Trampas Land Use Plan.

Depart for the Chen Landbank Parcel **11:05 a.m.**

From the Elworthy Staging Area return to San Ramon Valley Blvd. and turn right, continue approximately 1.5 miles and turn right onto Deerwood Rd. Continue approximately 0.8 miles and turn right onto Deerwood Dr. Continue for approximately 0.5 miles and turn right onto Bollinger Canyon Rd. Follow Bollinger Canyon Rd. for 1.6 miles and park off the side of the road next to the corrals.

Arrive at the Chen Landbank Parcel **11:20 a.m.**

The Board will assemble and hear a brief presentation from Park District Principal Planner Neoma Lavelle about how plans for a proposed staging area at this location fit into the Southern Las Trampas Land Use Plan.

Depart for Little Hills **11:40 a.m.**

Continue north on Bollinger Canyon Rd. approximately 2.5 miles to the entrance of Las Trampas Regional Wilderness. Turn into the gravel lot on the left-hand side of the road, the group will then enter the park and walk into Little Hills for lunch

Lunch at Little Hills – Corral Group Camp **11:50 a.m.**

Lunch not provided to the public. Members of the public please bring your bag lunch. Beverages will be provided.

Corral Group Camp **12:30 p.m.**

The Board will receive a brief presentation from Project Manager Toby Perry on the recent repairs and improvements at Little Hills.

Depart for Holly Court **12:45 p.m.**

From Little Hills follow Elderberry Trail back to Bollinger Canyon Rd. turn right and continue on Bollinger Canyon Rd. approximately 1 mile, the entrance to Holly Ct. will be on the left-hand side of the road. Parking is available along the side of Holly Ct.

Arrive at Holly Court **12:50 p.m.**

The Board will assemble and hear a brief presentation from Project Manager Toby Perry on the removal of buildings from Holly Court. Park District Civil Engineer Shun Yu will give a brief presentation on the replacement of the Trecor water tank.

Depart for Peralta Oaks **1:15 p.m.**

From Holly Court turn left and continue approximately 3.5 miles and turn right onto Crow Canyon Rd. Continue approximately 18.5 miles to Castro Valley Blvd. and turn left. Then merge right onto I-580 west. Continue on I-580 west and take exit #30 Foothill/MacArthur exit, take slight right onto Foothill Blvd, turn right on 106th Ave., turn right on Peralta Oaks Ct. travel 0.25 miles and turn left into EBRPD parking lot.

Arrive at Peralta Oaks **2:00 p.m.**

Please note: The public will not be allowed to drive their personal vehicles on Park District Trails. All times listed are approximate.
