Del Valle Regional Park - Find, identify, and record life all around us. Meet at the Arroyo Rd Staging Area.

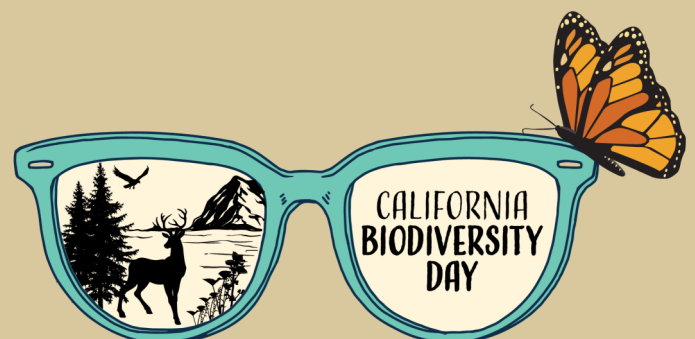
