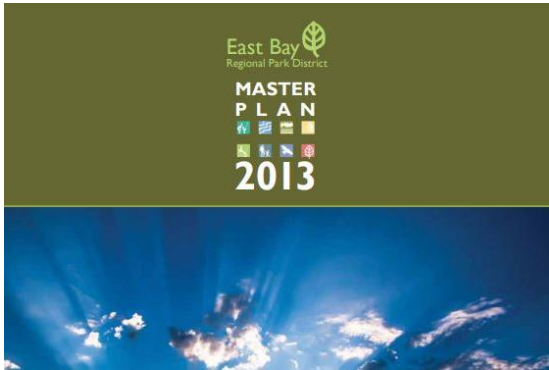

— Report on Proposed Park Reservations for East Bay Cities, Olmsted Brothers and Ansel F. Hall, December, 1930

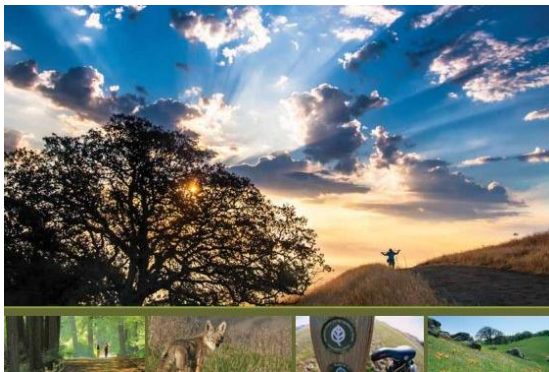
This statement, expressed at the conception of the District, continues to be an inspiration and an enduring testimonial to the social and environmental responsibilities that the agency must address. With this Master Plan the Board of Directors re-dedicates the East Bay Regional Park District to the conservation of open space resources and the provision of outdoor recreational opportunities for present and future generations.

The Mission statement defines the essential role of the District:

The East Bay Regional Park District preserves a rich heritage of natural and cultural resources and provides open space, parks, trails, safe and healthful recreation and environmental education. An environmental ethic guides the District in all of its activities.

The Vision statement sets the direction, values and objectives of the District:

The District envisions an extraordinary and well-managed system of open space parkland in Alameda and Contra Costa counties, which will forever provide the opportunity for

Supporting environmental and cultural education opportunities is important for empowering East Bay communities to appreciate and care for their natural surroundings. In their work, the PAC will work to promote park accessibility and engagement with all communities, including under-resourced groups and those with varying abilities. By supporting the Park District in actively working with Indigenous communities and offering programs in multiple languages, the PAC can help create opportunities for more people to explore and develop a deeper understanding of their local environment.

As the Park District works to maintain and expand its park network, trails, educational and recreational programming, and accessibility for the public, it is vital to remember the District's overarching mission to be guided by an environmental ethic in all its activities. To preserve the natural landscapes that we see today, the PAC must work to incorporate a focus on stewardship and balance of ecological interests in its deliberations.

Providing support to the Park District through advocacy and community oversight, the Park Advisory Committee will maintain a strong understanding of current and future funding programs to effectively advocate for resources which support park projects and initiatives. By staying informed, the PAC can help ensure transparency, accountability, and fiscal wellbeing for the Park District.

This objective represents the core mission of the Park Advisory Committee. As members of the PAC participate in open dialogue and advise the Board on key initiatives, they ensure the work of the Park District advances in a way that is equitable and responsive to the needs of the community. This promotes inclusivity and transparency within park governance, and ensures the District effectively serves all members of the East Bay community.
