<p>Connections to Long Ago: Living and Working on an 1890s Farm</p> <p>Get a glimpse into life on an 1890s farm, as costumed Naturalists demonstrate some typical farm tasks. Students will make connections between farms and things they use in everyday life, considering what has changed over time, and what remains the same.</p>	K – 1 st	20 minutes	1 class
<p>From Field to Food: How Farms Have Fed Us Through History</p> <p>Track foods from the field to the dinner plate, as a Naturalist in an 1890s period costume guides your students' exploration of a historic farm. Compare and contrast historical methods of farming and cooking with modern technology as we transform crops into food.</p>	2 nd	30 minutes	1 class
<p>Cultivating Gold: 250 Years of Farming in California</p> <p>Trace the evolution of farming in California, while virtually exploring the grounds of Ardenwood. Historic buildings and artifacts, along with maps, photographs, diaries, and other primary sources will help students learn about the people and events that shaped their community.</p>	3 rd	40 minutes	1 class
