### UPDATE ON CALIFORNIA'S 30X30 INITIATIVE August 3, 2023

On October 7, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Nature-based Solutions Executive Order N-82- 20 (30x30 EO) to advance biodiversity conservation by implementing nature-based solutions to adapt to climate change. The Executive Order sets a goal for California conserve thirty percent (30%) of its lands and coastal waters by 2030.

In April 2023, the California Natural Resources Agency released the *Pathways to 30x30 California* – *Accelerating Conservation of California's Nature* report (Pathways Report) that provides an overview of the progress to date and establishes strategic actions to implement the Governor Newsom's 30x30 policy.

The Pathways Report highlights the Governor's Executive Order directive to meet three critical objectives, described as:

- I. Protect and Restore Biodiversity;
- 2. Improves Equitable Access to Nature for All and Reflect the Needs and Interests of Local Communities;
- 3. Mitigate and Build Resilience to Climate Change through Climate-Smart Land Management.

The East Bay Regional Park District, under the leadership of Deputy General Manager Dr. Ana M. Alvarez, has been an integral member of the 30x30 Steering Committee and in advocating for investment that aligns with the Park District's current practices to advance the 30x30 objectives in the East Bay.

Staff will provide an overview of the  $30 \times 30$  initiative, the Pathways Report, and ongoing actions to implement the Nature Based Solutions Executive Order.
