Family Campsites

Per night, tent site.....	\$30
Per night, Del Valle full hook-up site, sewer, water, 50/30/120 amp.....	\$45
Per night, Anthony Chabot full hook-up site sewer, water, electric 30 amp.....	\$40
Per night, Anthony Chabot tent hike-in.....	\$25



Backpacking Sites

Per person, per night (age 16+).....	\$5
Age 15 and under.....	Free

MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

Additional permits may be required.

Additional Fees

Non-refundable reservation fee..... \$8

Dog fee per dog/night, where allowed.....\$2

Swimming, boating, fishing, and other costs are not included in the camping fee.

Additional permits are required for access to the Ohlone Wilderness Trail and East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) property.

Cabin Campsites

Per night, Del Valle cabin site.....	\$100
Additional refundable security deposit.....	\$100

Reservations for family and cabin campsites includes one vehicle. Maximum of two vehicles are allowed per site. The second vehicle will pay the \$8 fee at check-in. Carpooling is highly encouraged as overflow parking is extremely limited.

Group Sites

All rates are per night.

Primitive Group Sites

50 person or less capacity.....	\$75
75 person capacity.....	\$100
100 person capacity.....	\$125
150 person capacity.....	\$175
300 person capacity.....	\$200

Developed Group Sites

50 person capacity, Puma Point (Anthony Chabot).....	\$100
50 person capacity, Wild Turkey (Del Valle)...	\$150
75 person capacity, Punta Vaca (Del Valle).....	\$100

Group site fees are based on site size. A refundable security deposit is charged on all group camp reservations.

How to Make Your Reservation

Reserve by phone or in person at Park District headquarters. Family campsites may also be reserved online.

For family campgrounds, reserve at least two business days, and up to 12 weeks, in advance. Advance reservations are encouraged, as sites usually sell out every weekend.

For all other sites, reserve at least five business days in advance. Group and backpack sites become available for reservations in November for Alameda and Contra Costa county residents, and the following January for non-residents.

Changes, Cancellations, and Refunds

Call the Reservations Department to change or cancel your reservations. No refunds are offered due to unfavorable weather.

The \$8 change fee or cancellation fee is in addition to the non-refundable initial reservation fee of \$8.

Family Campgrounds

You must make changes or cancel your trip more than two days before your arrival date.

If you call to cancel your trip fewer than two days before your trip, there is no refund.

Group and Cabin Sites

Cancellations made:

- 30 days or more prior to the reservation – 90% refund
- 15 days or more prior to the reservation – 75% refund
- Less than 15 days, but more than 7 days – 50% refund
- Under 7 days – no refund

Healthy Parks Healthy People

Family Campsites

- Up to 8 people per site.
- Each household may reserve up to two sites.
- Tent, trailer/RV, or hike-in sites are available.
- Organized groups are encouraged to use the Group Campsites.
- Sunol Regional Wilderness family and group camps are currently closed.

Group Campsites

- Available in 12 parks, for groups of 11 to 300 people. Developed and primitive sites are available.

Cabin Campsites

- Sleeps up to five people per cabin.
- Each household may reserve **one** cabin.
- Two-night minimum on weekends (Fri., Sat., Sun.) from April 1 to Oct. 31.

Backpack Camping

Hike into one of seven parks to spend the night under the stars. Additional permits are required at some parks.

Equestrian Camping

Saddle up and ride out to one of our equestrian campsites. Located in five different parks with sites for up to 75 horses.

For All Sites

- All camping reservations begin at 2 p.m., and end at noon the following day, except cabin sites. Cabin check in begins at 3 p.m. and ends at 11 a.m.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Reservations are site-specific. Call the Park District Reservations staff to help you determine the site that meets your needs, or view sites online at ebparks.org/camping.
