## NEAT STUFF WITH A NATURALIST

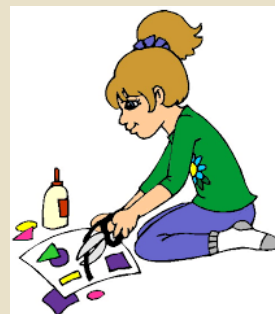


