


How to 'Propose a Service Project' with the East Bay Regional Park's Volunteer Services

If a volunteer would like to apply to complete a specific volunteer project in the park, they can follow these steps to submit an application. Volunteers will have to create an account with the district to submit a proposal, but this account can also be used to register for volunteer opportunities district wide! Here are the steps you'll need to follow to submit an application.



Service Projects include:

- Individual Volunteer Projects
- Group Volunteer Projects
- Eagle and Gold Scouts Volunteer Projects
- Trail Maintenance Projects
- Docent Interest Form


1. Navigate to our Programs page: https://apply.ebparks.org/custom/501/volunteer_home
2. Hover the mouse over the Volunteer Programs page and select the **Propose a Service Project** button.



3. This will prompt the volunteer to either sign-in or create a new account. Whichever option is chosen, it will eventually lead the participant to their account **Dashboard**. From the participant's dashboard they can view volunteer shifts, see the programs they are registered with, and request a program. They will also be required to complete the East Bay Regional Park District COVID waiver.



4. Information from the participants profile will self-populate. The volunteer will then be given the opportunity to apply for one of our Service Projects.
Please note: if the volunteer is a Scout applying for an Eagle or Gold Project, please add your parent or guardian as the Co-Coordinator for the application.
