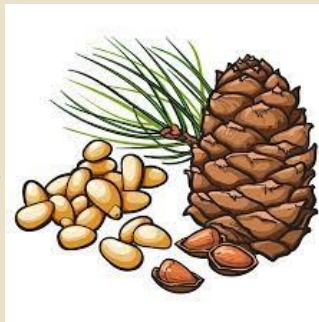


## ABALONE AND PINE NUT BEAD NECKLACE MAKING

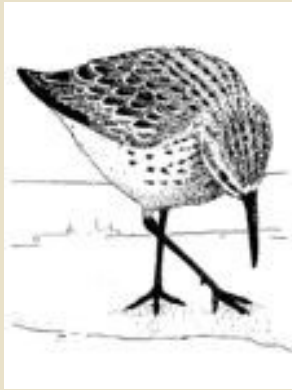
