Trail Length 0.1 mi (0.2 km)

Network trail

This trail crosses a dam and picnic areas, connecting the East shore and West shore trails at the north end of the park.

Cumulative Elevation Change **Gain 4 ft (1 m)**
Loss 9 ft (3 m)



Typical Grade is 1.9%

8% of the trail is between 8% and 9%
58 ft (18 m) is between 8% and 9%
8% grade is a standard ramp.



Typical Cross Slope is 2.8%

22% of the trail is between 5% and 8%
157 ft (48 m) is between 5% and 8%



Typical Tread Width is 95 in (241 cm)

Tread Width ranges from 76 in (193 cm) to 96 in (244 cm)
Minimum Clearance 76 in (193 cm)



Trail Surface is Vegetation - Mown

92% of the trail is Firm or better
640 ft (195 m) of the trail is Firm or better
