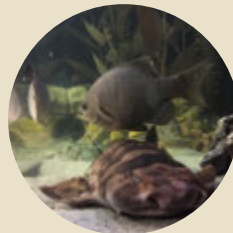
Sat, Dec 11: Encinal Beach

Discover what's on the menu for our bay critters as you get up close and personal while they feed.





