Description	Grade	Duration
<p><b>Naturalist in the Classroom</b> (virtual or in-person)            Note: For the in-person option, on-site parking must be available for our cargo van</p>		
<p><b>Reptiles / Amphibians</b>            Students review the differences between reptiles, amphibians, and humans, and meet a real reptile! Available all seasons.</p>	All Grades	30 - 60 minutes per class
<p><b>Plants</b>            Students learn the six plant parts and their importance to both plants and humans. Available all seasons.</p>		
<p><b>Lifecycles</b>            Students discover the similarities and differences of the unique lifecycles of living things (including ourselves!) Observe and draw living specimens in different stages of their lifecycles! Available all seasons.</p>		
<p><b>Nature Walk</b> (virtual or in-person)</p>		
<p>Experience the Regional Parks with a digital-based hike hosted by one of our naturalists in the field. The program's theme of either <b>Plants</b> or <b>Habitats</b>, aligns with NGSS. Available all seasons. Note: This program depends on current air quality conditions and may need to be adapted.</p>	All Grades	30 - 60 minutes per class
